us breathe. Most trees lose their leaves in

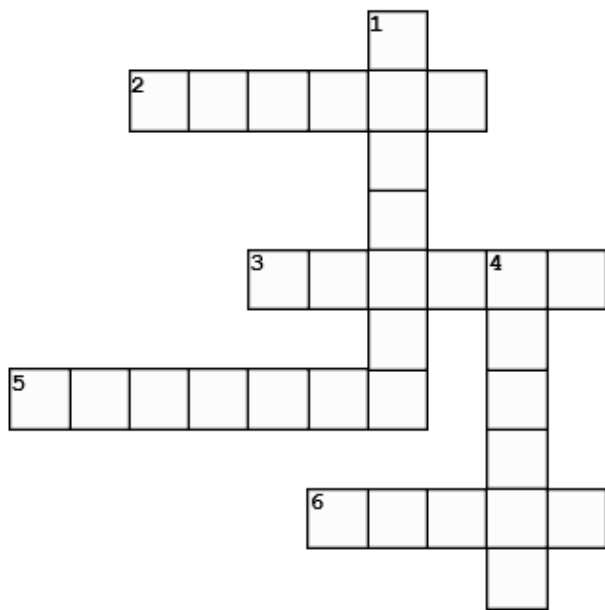
winter, but evergreen trees always have
