to life. Easter eggs are empty inside to

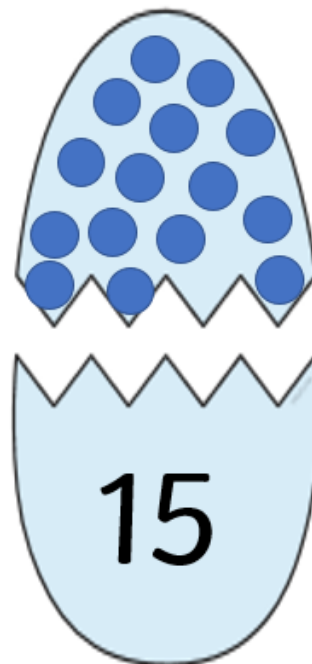
show that the cave where Jesus died
